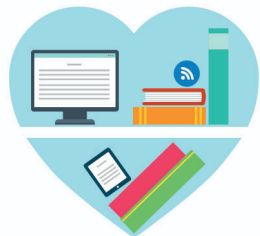
CHRISTMAS FAIR

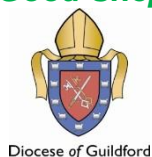

12 Values of Christmas

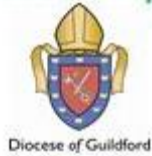

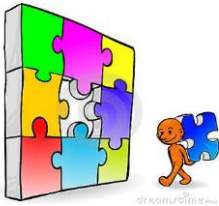
