Dear Parents,

As part of our class transition topic on "Elmer", Year R have booked a trip to West Wittering Beach on Friday 19th July.

Unfortunately, a number of parents decided not to contribute to the cost of school trips last year and the school have had to pay the shortfall. As you know, our budget does not allow for this and therefore we can now only proceed with trips where we have received full donations otherwise we will have to cancel them.

Donation to the cost of £13.00 and permission from every child needs to be received by Friday 14th June in order for the trip to go ahead.

Please pay and give consent via our new online system Tucasi, bearing in mind you must give consent first before it will let you pay for the trip.

We will travel to Wittering in minibuses. We will be leaving at 8.30am and returning between 3 and 4pm depending on weather (we will text to school to let you know our approximate arrival time).

The children will need a packed lunch. If you would like the school to provide you with either meat or veg option, please **email letters@holme.goodshepherdtrust.org.uk** and request a lunch. They will need their named water bottle as well as a second drink for having with their lunch.

All the children should be dressed in their school PE uniform of PE shorts and white T-shirt. All children must bring a sunhat, preferably with a wide brim and be wearing shoes that you feel are suitable for a day at the beach. Your child may wear sunglasses if you wish. Further information regarding clothing may follow if the weather conditions change. All children also need to bring in their own named bucket and spade.

Children should arrive at school with sun cream **already applied**. If you have already provided sun cream for your child in class this will also be taken to reapply on the trip.

The £13 donation covers the cost of the transport and an ice lolly from the café for each child. We will also be taking the usual fruit snacks and extra drinks and cups.
