FROTH's Big Family Camp Out

On Friday 22nd September we are holding a big family camp out. The idea is that you bring your tent to school on the Friday evening, pitch up and then we have a BBQ followed by some field games. A few toasted marshmallows and S'Mores later we bed down for the night, using the outside toilets. Waking up in the morning we will have bacon butties, packing up and leaving the school grounds at 10am at the latest.

You pay £3 per adult and £1 per child and then £2 for burgers or hot dogs and £2 for bacon butties. You pre-order the food and send your money in, so we have an idea of quantities for food, plus it means that you do not need to have any money on site.

Spending

As it is that time of year again, where the school must work out their budget, we had a meeting with Ms Worswick and it was decided that we will introduce a bi-annual save and spending regime. The money raised by the Christmas and summer fairs will be saved over two years and then spent on a large item/items. So this academic year and next academic years; fair takings will be spent in July 2018. It has been decided that the money will be spent on laptops, as I'm sure you can appreciate, technology is a fast paced subject and the children need to be kept up to date, and that can only be achieved by having the relevant technology. We will still give 60% of our other funds raised (through other events we hold such as cake sales, camp outs) to the school, who will spend it where it is needed. We will no longer be doing the voting system, as the need for decent laptops is greater. The outside area and library will still receive money through the 60% of funds given to the school by FROTH (so don't worry about saving milk bottle tops anymore!).

Bag 2 School

We have booked in the Bag 2 School people to come 3 times next year. The good news is that they now take soft toys, old sheets and towels. We have booked them in the weeks just after the 3 half term holidays, so you can use the week to have a good clear out. All of the bags collected raise money for the school. A Bag 2 School bag will come home the week before half term, but you can use black binliners too. Just make sure they are securely tied up and have no holes in them.
