Entrance to the cinema is free but we need to ask for a donation for the cost of transport. The children will travel by minibus and car. The cost is £6.

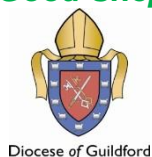

Dear Parents

This is to let you know that Year 3 will start there Forest Schools lessons during this term. Mr Milam will be leading this with the class teacher and the lessons will relate to the class topic based around the story of 'Where the Wild Things Are'.

The dates are as follows:

Thursday 2nd November
Thursday 9th November
Thursday 16th November

Ideally the children should wear the following as a minimum:

Vest
Short or long sleeved tee shirt
Jumper or fleece (1 or 2 thinner ones work well)
A hat which will fit under a hood
Gloves or mittens which may be worn when required
2 pairs of socks
Jogging bottoms

These lessons will start at 09.00am till 12.00pm. As it is coming into the Autumn months and the forest can be very cold and wet, please ensure that your child has several layers of clothing on with a change of socks. The children should come to school in their forest school clothes and can stay in them for the whole day. Please make sure though that they do have a change of socks and dry shoes or boots. The school will provide waterproofs for all the children.

Dear Parents,

As part of our Houses and Homes topic, Years One and Two are visiting Weald and Downland Museum in Chichester. Through this visit the children will be able to explore the different houses and homes and explore the different materials used to build them.

The visit will take place on **Tuesday 28th November 2017**. We will be travelling by coach and we are asking for a donation of £9.00 per child to cover the cost of the coaches and also entrance to the museum. We would be grateful if this could be paid by **Friday 24th November 2017**.
