We are delighted to be continuing our after school clubs in 2018 at The Holme Primary School.

Over the last half term we have been able to assess the needs of parents, the space available to us at the school and desires of your children, which hopefully enables us, cater for everyone. We have made some small changes for the New Year and the club is now ready for you to book online - we thought getting it booked before the Christmas celebrations in readiness for the new term would be one less thing to worry about.

2018 - SPRING TERM

Everyday the children will arrive straight after school and have the opportunity to have a snack and drink.

We will then stay in the art room where children will be able to play board games, with the Wii, be creative drawing or taking part in a team challenge like marshmallow sky scrapers.

At 4:30 each day they can either stay in the art room and continue with those activities or move to the hall for our skills classes, where other children will then join to take part in these skills classes. We ask that if the child chooses to do all or some of the below that they agree to do so every week.
