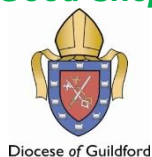

Dear Parents

This is to let you know that Year 4/5 will start their Forest Schools lessons during this term. Mr Milam will be leading this with the class teacher and the lessons will relate to the class topic based around 'Extreme Survival'.

The dates are as follows:

Thursday 18th January
Thursday 25th January
Thursday 1st February

Ideally the children should wear the following as a minimum:

Vest
Short or long sleeved tee shirt
Jumper or fleece (1 or 2 thinner ones work well)
A hat which will fit under a hood
Gloves or mittens which may be worn when required
2 pairs of socks
Jogging bottoms

These lessons will start at 09.00am till 12.00pm. As we are in the Spring months and the forest can still be very cold and wet, please ensure that your child has several layers of clothing on with a change of socks. The children should come to school in their forest school clothes and can stay in them for the whole day. Please make sure though that they do have a change of socks and dry shoes or boots. The school will provide waterproofs for all the children.

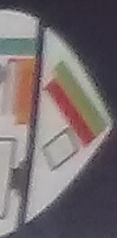
