# Whitehill & Bordon Integration Project: Public Exhibition

## Open Events

Hampshire County Council is inviting local Whitehill & Bordon residents and businesses to see proposals designed to improve how people can travel around the town once the new relief road is open.

### The plans and proposals will be on display;

- **Friday 13th July 2018** between 1pm and 7pm at the Forest Community Centre, Pinehill Road, Bordon, GU35 0BS
- **Saturday 14th July 2018** between 10am and 1pm at the Mustangs, Budds Lane, Bordon, GU35 0JE
- **Monday 16th July 2018** between 1pm and 5pm at the Forest Community Centre, Pinehill Road, Bordon, GU35 0BS

Local people are being asked for their views until 9 September, when all feedback will be collated and taken into account as the schemes are developed.

## What is the Whitehill & Bordon Integration Project?

The Whitehill & Bordon Integration Project is a collection of transport schemes planned to be put in place over a number of years. Once fully open the relief road will become the A325, allowing through traffic to be removed from the existing road, although local traffic will still continue to use this route.

The plans involve a package of transport measures to support Whitehill & Bordon's regeneration into a Green and Healthy Town, including:

- widening footways to provide more and safer routes for pedestrians and cyclists
- providing more safer crossing points for pedestrians and cyclists
- making it easy for existing residents to access the new facilities
- making it easier for local drivers to get about
- reducing traffic speeds in key locations such as the entrance to the new town centre
