Half term is here! This half term seems to have flown by, although in other ways it seems like I have been with you for years, not weeks! I'd like to start by thanking you all so much for making me feel so welcome at The Holme. I have thoroughly enjoyed the last few weeks, getting to know you all and of course getting to know your lovely children! It did occur to me that some of you might not have met me yet. I have tried to be out on the gate most mornings but please do introduce yourselves to me if we haven't already met.

We had an exciting start to the week this week, with the filming of our virtual video tour of the school. I felt very proud as I showed our filmmaker around and talked about all the wonderful things we do at The Holme. I am waiting for the draft version to come my way. Once I have seen it and thoroughly checked that it complies with permissions etc., it will be available for you and prospective parents to view on our school website. On that note, please do spread the word amongst any of your friends who might be in the process of choosing a school for their child on how amazing we are here! Thank you.

Thank you, also, so much for your support around mask wearing on site this week—again it is very much appreciated and I have particularly enjoyed seeing all of your different types of masks on your way into school. Also thank you again for all your support around start times and attendance. I know these have been very strange times and we really appreciate how tricky it has been for some families, especially with siblings in different bubbles.

Talking about attendance, although we are trying to be as flexible and understanding as possible, please can I remind you that anyone who arrives over 10 minutes after their bubble time without prior discussion with us, will be marked as late and anything after that will be classed as an unauthorised absence. Please avoid taking holidays during term time. We cannot authorise such absences and they will also be classed as unauthorised.

Our Zoom parent consultation meetings happened this week. I have had some really positive feedback from the meetings as well as some stories of 'technical difficulties'. If you were not able to meet with your class teacher for any reason, please do contact us so that we can arrange a telephone consultation.

I have a couple of end of term reminders for you. Pencil cases—your child should be bringing his or her pencil case home this afternoon. Please can you take some time over the half term break to replenish it? School uniform—all of our children came back so smart after the summer break but I'm seeing trainers and jewellery are starting to sneak their way back in again! Children should be in smart, polishable standard school shoes on non PE days, although trainers are absolutely fine on the days when children come in PE kits. Only small stud earrings should be worn to school, no necklaces or bracelets, and no jewellery at all on PE days. Please can I also remind you that all items should be clearly named.

This morning I sent out a questionnaire about access to technology at home, so that we have a clear idea of how we can plan effectively for remote learning, should we have a whole or partial school closure. I would also like feedback on how your child has settled back into school this term . Ofsted 'parent view' offer a questionnaire for parents. It would be extremely helpful if you were able to complete this for us, again so that we have a clear picture of need and can plan accordingly. Dear Parents,


