Dear Parents and Carers,

Friday already again!

I think this week's newsletter is going to be full of reminders! Now we are in the full swing of the winter months we are still gratefully accepting donations of tissue boxes, if you would like to send them in with your child. Please can you make sure that your child has a named coat with them in school and that hats are the warm, woolly type rather than the summer baseball cap? PE days-thank you for your co-operation in sending your children suitablly dressed on these days; please can I just remind you that we do have a set PE Kit:- a dark tracksuit, white or 'house coloured' t-shirt and any colour trainers. (We are seeing all sorts of fantastic attire coming into school-perfect for home but not really suitable for PE lessons!) On that note please can I also remind you about school shoes? We fully understand that there may be challenges however it does concern me that we cannot supervise children on site before their allocated time.

Other reminders from last week include Christmas cards and end of term. I apologise for the short notice, however in line with many other local schools we have decided to finish slightly early on the last day of term. Upper KS2 will finish at 1pm, lower KS2 at 1.10 and KS1/Year R will finish at 1.20pm. Please let us know if this causes any problems for you. Christmas happenings: I have enclosed some information from our lovely FROTH team as well as Christmas dinner information and Christmas jumper day information. Christmas cards, if you would like your child to write and send Christmas cards to children in their own class: we will set up post-boxes in each classroom from the beginning of December and run a system of quarantining the cards over weekends and only distributing them to the children on Mondays. We will have one final 'delivery' on the last day of term and the last 'Holme' Christmas posting day will be Tuesday 15th December. Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate cards across bubbles so children need to only send them to those within their class.


