

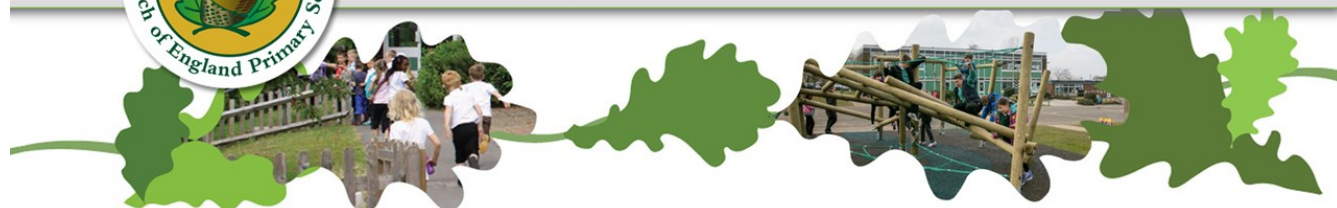

Admission into our school and secondary transfer September 2023

A reminder of information shared with you last week on applying for school places for the academic year 2023/24. We have our open morning for parents looking for infant places in September 2023 on November 3rd and I know many of our local secondary schools are holding their open evenings over the next few weeks. For transfer to Secondary School (Year 7) applications opened on 12 September 2022 and the deadline is 31 October 2022. You will then be notified on 1 March 2023.

Ideally the children should wear the following as a minimum:

- Vest
- Short or long sleeved tee shirt
- Jumper or fleece (1 or 2 thinner ones work well)
- A hat which will fit under a hood
- Gloves or mittens which may be worn when required
- 2 pairs of socks
- Jogging bottoms

As we are in the Autumn/Winter months and the forest can be very cold and wet, please ensure that your child has several layers of clothing on with a change of socks. The children should come to school in their forest school clothes and can stay in them for the whole day. Please make sure though that they do have a change of socks and dry shoes or boots. If you have your own waterproofs from home then please do wear them however the school have a supply for you to wear!

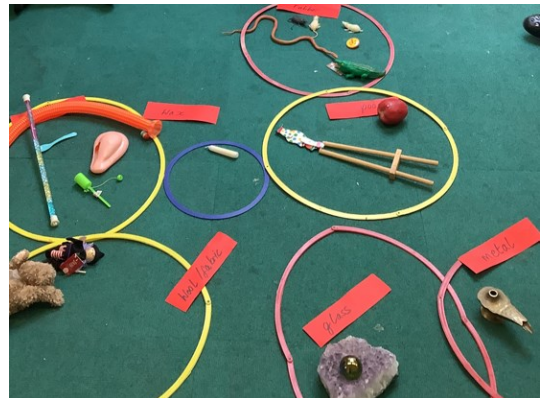
